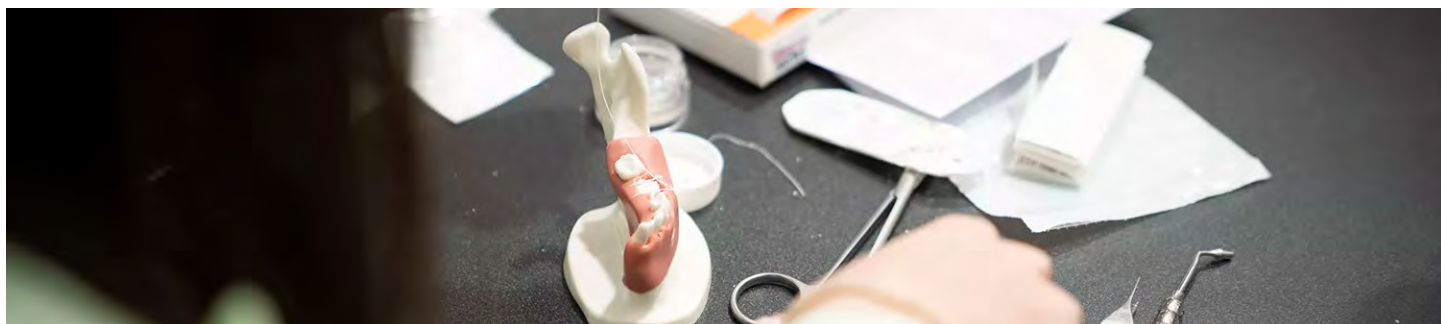
Maxillary Ridge Expansion Using the Split-cortical Technique and Mandibular Ridge Expansion Using the Pedicled Sandwich Plasty Technique

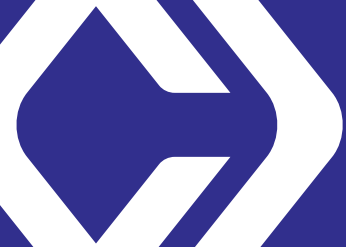
Deficiency in alveolar ridge dimensions represents a challenge for implant placement. A variety of bone grafting techniques have been developed over the years to overcome this challenge. While most of these techniques work, selecting the proper grafting method is important, as the operator needs to select the most optimal technique according to the specifics of the case they are treating. In particular, the ridge resorption pattern is a major factor in determining the best bone grafting option.

In this lecture, Dr Louie Al-Faraje will present a practical bone resorption classification system with the appropriate bone grafting techniques per class. Extensive coverage of the split-cortical technique and pedicled sandwich plasty will be provided, including indications, step-by-step surgical protocols, bone grafting materials, postoperative care, and more.

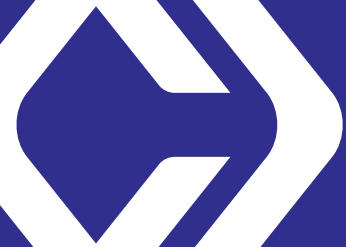

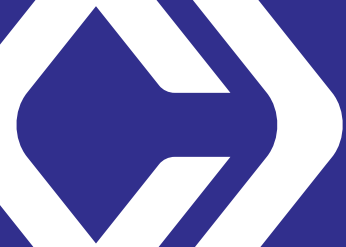


Table Clinic and Poster Presentations

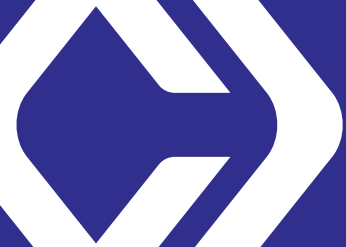
